He will supply us with both fill dirt and road base. Jeff Fryer request that county may still store equipment here and will put their own lock on the gate.

Clay Brown on Tack Rd off HWY 281 has had low water pressure since 2004. He has talked to Billy several times about it through the years. Usage on bills shows 0 usage a lot of the time. Nineteen months his water usage was 0. Usage ranges from 0 thirteen times in last 70 months. 10 months it is 12000 gallons a month average when 50 or 60 calves there. It averages 14000 in last 6 years. Going forward with new style of meter that will be accurate. August meter is correct going forward. Rebekah will print out bill and mail in envelope. We will charge tier 1 for the water use of the past that has been averaged. We know we need several new pressure stations and getting with engineers on how to best manage these pressure issues. If the stations require storage, it is \$750,000.00. 35 psi required by TCEQ for each customer. Line is 45 at meter and is 2 inches then to 1 to house. Chase can bring a pressure logger to get true info to send to

engineers. The meter info is coming from a satellite google earth with altitudes figured in not true water pressure. Down his road before his house, they use average of 300,000 gallons a month.

We doubled our usage in last 3 years on gallons of water sold. James Smith said we need to be at 6.35 we pay 19 wholesale rates. He shifts where base rate is 80 or 100 and then cost per gallon way down. It gets us thinking about budget. We know what money we will get each month 2 to 8000 gallons are our average this month's bill \$112.00 versus \$176.00.

Palo Pinto has a contingency fund that pays for unexpected expenses. 10,000 and above was high water usage. Base+ rate 0 - 10000 goes to variable 10000+ goes to contingency. If they sell a meter its (capital improvement) impact fee. Things budget committee can think about.

Bad Debts

How long after meter has been pulled should we close account. 6 MONTHS is a realistic amount of time to try to collect if people sell property. When meter is pulled it turns into a collection account. Label as turned off account. Get dead meter off. No usage meters need to pay each month. Pull meter if more than one house on meter and they haven't been paying for both meters. Label as turned off account. Get Dead meter. If they have a meter, they are supposed to be paying each month. Tariff requires payment. Make sure we are going by tariff. Will notify customers of new changes
